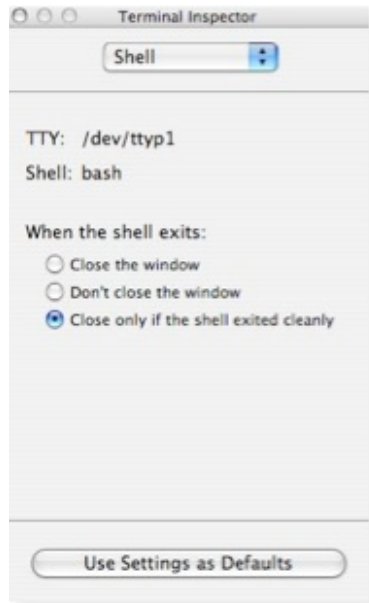
### Mac OS X related Frequently Asked Questions

#### **What Macs is Tracker available for**

The Tracker Software is currently available for Intel Macs, any model. We recommend at least 4 gigabytes of memory. While an Intel Mac is needed to run the Tracker Application itself, a Power PC based Mac can be used to access the Tracker Application as a remote workstation.

#### **How to set up the Terminal Application to close when a Tracker application is closed.**



Open the Terminal Application and from the Terminal drop-down menu select Window Settings.

The Terminal Inspector dialog will open.

Select Shell from the menu and then click the *Close only if the shell exited cleanly* radio button as shown in the image.

Click the *Use Settings as Defaults* button and when you next open a Tracker window it will close when you exit the application running in the window.

### **How can I reset the Terminal Application to its default settings**

Use the Finder to browse to the Library folder in your Home folder and then open the Preferences folder. Find the file **com.apple.Terminal.plist** and move it to the Trash. Next time you run Terminal a new plist file will be created with Terminal default settings.
